

# FORD BRONCO SPORT RECALLED OVER ABS MODULE LEAK ISSUE

Ford Motor Company is recalling select 2023 Ford Bronco Sport models over an ABS module leak issue.

**The defect:** in affected vehicles, valves inside the anti-lock brake system module may have been damaged during manufacturing, causing an internal ABS module leak.

**The hazards:** a leak inside the ABS module can cause an unexpected increase in brake pedal travel or unexpected movement during an Auto Hold event, increasing the risk of a crash.

Ford is not aware of any reports of accidents or injuries related to this condition.

**Components:** ABS module

**Affected vehicles:** select 2023 Ford Bronco Sport models produced between December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022, and December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

**Number of vehicles affected:** 801

**The fix:** dealers will replace the ABS Module, free of charge.

**Owners should:** wait for communications from Ford, which will begin February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The Ford reference number for this recall is 23S01.
