


Removal

NOTE: Left hand (LH) shown, right hand (RH) similar.

- 1. Remove the following items:
 - 1. Remove the rear scuff plate trim panel.
 - Refer to: Rear Scuff Plate Trim Panel (501-05 Interior Trim and Ornamentation, Removal and Installation).
 - 2. Remove the D-pillar trim panel.
 - Refer to: D-Pillar Trim Panel (501-05 Interior Trim and Ornamentation, Removal and Installation).
 - Remove the loadspace scuff plate trim panel.
 Refer to: Loadspace Scuff Plate Trim Panel (501-05 Interior Trim and Ornamentation, Removal and Installation).
- 2. Position the liftgate weatherstrip aside.



3. Remove the floor storage bin.





4. Remove the rear seat backrest. Refer to: Rear Seat Backrest (501-10B Rear Seats, Removal and Installation).


Left hand side

- Remove the loadspace trim panel.

 1. Release the loadspace trim panel clips.
 Use the General Equipment: Interior Trim Remover

 2. Position the rear seatbelt retractor and pretensioner through the opening in the loadspace trim panel.

 3. Disconnect the power outlet electrical connector.





Right hand side


- Remove the loadspace trim panel.

 1. Release the loadspace trim panel clips.
 Use the General Equipment: Interior Trim Remover

 2. Position the rear seatbelt retractor and pretensioner through the opening in the loadspace trim panel.

 3. Disconnect the power outlet electrical connector.

 - 4. Disconnect the loadspace trim panel interior lamp electrical connector.5. Disconnect the power point electrical connector.



Installation

NOTE: During installation, make sure the seatbelt webbing is not twisted and seatbelts and buckles are accessible to the occupants.
 To install, reverse the removal procedure.
